



Ecosystems & Climate Change Summer Internship Program

The Center for Ecosystem Climate Solutions (CECS), a multi-institution collaboration based at the University of California, announces its summer undergraduate intern program for 2020. The interns will join a team of scientists and land managers who are working to understand and reduce the impact of climate change on ecosystems and forests. The 8-week summer program includes a kick-off workshop in Yosemite National Park that will include field visits and an overview of the issues; a 7-week internship at UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Davis, or San Diego State University; and a close-out workshop at UC Irvine that will include a discussion of progress.

Opportunities range from field and geospatial research to outreach and community engagement. Some interns will focus on the analyses and science needed to develop climate change solutions for natural ecosystems, while other interns will work with cooperative extension offices, campus researchers, and land managers to identify needs and communicate knowledge to action.

The program targets a cohort of inquisitive and motivated undergraduates who are majoring in fields such as earth science, environmental science and policy, ecology, forestry, natural resource management, geography, hydrology, data science or engineering. Applicants should be currently enrolled undergraduates who will have completed at least their sophomore year by summer 2020; high school students, rising sophomores, or graduate students are not eligible.

\$15/hour for 40 hours of work/week for 8 weeks

Interns will be based at UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Davis, or San Diego State University

Must be available to start in mid-June and work through mid-August.
